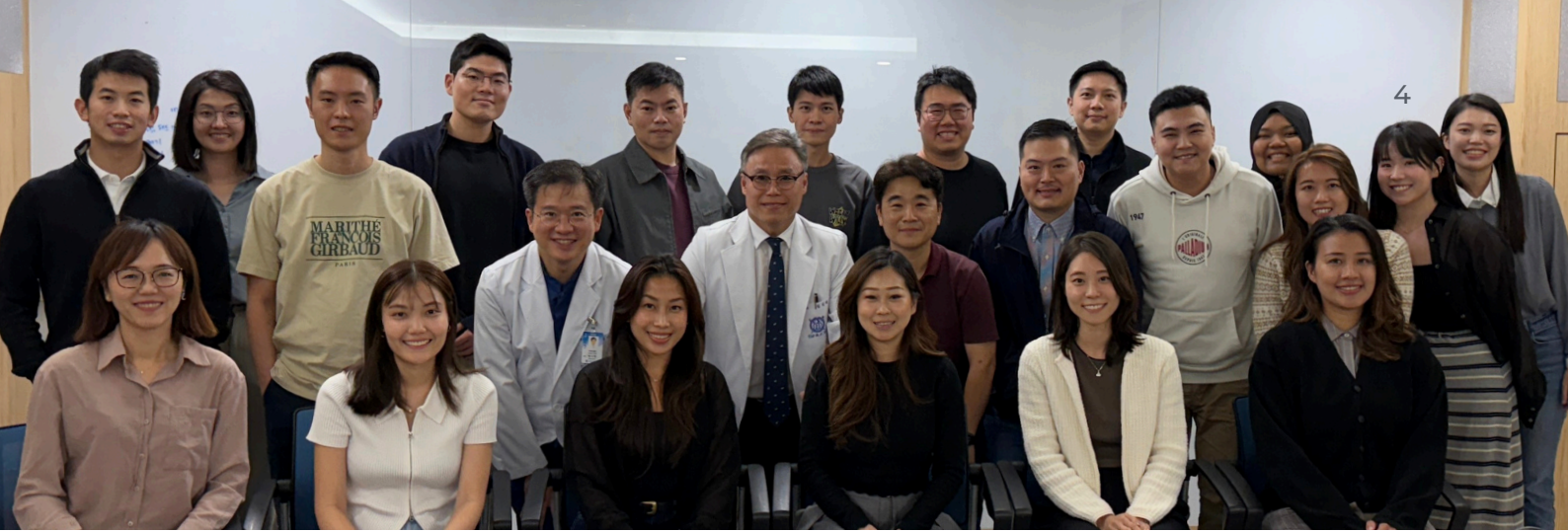
ABOUT SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Achieving Predictable Anterior Aesthetics: A Focus on Free Gingival Graft and Connective Tissue Graft

The stability of peri-implant tissues is considered a crucial factor for the long-term success of implants. When the vestibule around the implant restoration is shallow, and the peri-implant mucosa is highly mobile, it can hinder proper oral hygiene maintenance and compromise the implant's longevity. To improve this environment, APF (Apically Positioned Flap) and FGG (Free Gingival Graft) are performed to increase the vestibular depth and the keratinized mucosa. This lecture and hand-on seminar will cover the indications for APF & FGG and the theoretical knowledge and practical skills needed for their successful application in relevant cases.

**Connective Tissue Graft:
Characteristics of Connective Tissue, Importance of Gingival
Thickness & Technical Notes for Harvesting Connective Tissue**

with Hands-on

It is already known that the surgical part (pink esthetics) is essential for optimal results in the anterior region. A connective tissue graft is necessary for more aesthetic results beyond the functional part. However, selecting appropriate cases and the technique to perform the procedure according to the surgeon's preference can be a great tool for clinicians. Although the use of artificial gingiva is helpful, autogenous gingiva should ultimately be harvested. This course can be approached in various ways and practiced with Pig-jaw under conditions similar to the actual situation.

Strategy of Clear Aligner for Patient in Need of Dental Prosthesis

Tremendous innovation has been achieved in clear aligner treatment over the past 10 to 20 years. Nowadays, clear aligners have been widely adopted among middle-aged patients, and there is a trend toward adjunctive orthodontic treatment with clear aligners to establish the appropriate prosthodontic process. In this lecture, we will discuss the right strategies for proper use of clear aligner treatment for prosthodontic patients and contemplate a practical treatment process.

Rationale, Principle, & Focusing on Minimum Thickness for Fracture Resistance

with Hands-on

We will discuss in depth the understanding of fracture modes, which are not usually covered in detail in laminate lectures. Why do fractures occur? The various mechanisms of fracture were explained academically and intuitively in an easy-to-understand manner. When accompanied by an understanding of fracture, the understanding of preparation design deepens and becomes easier. Diagnosis and patient communication in ceramic laminate can be difficult because subjectivity regarding aesthetics is involved. We will also discuss the aesthetic try-in method, which is useful for communicating with patients and for the easy production of preparation guides and provisional restorations.

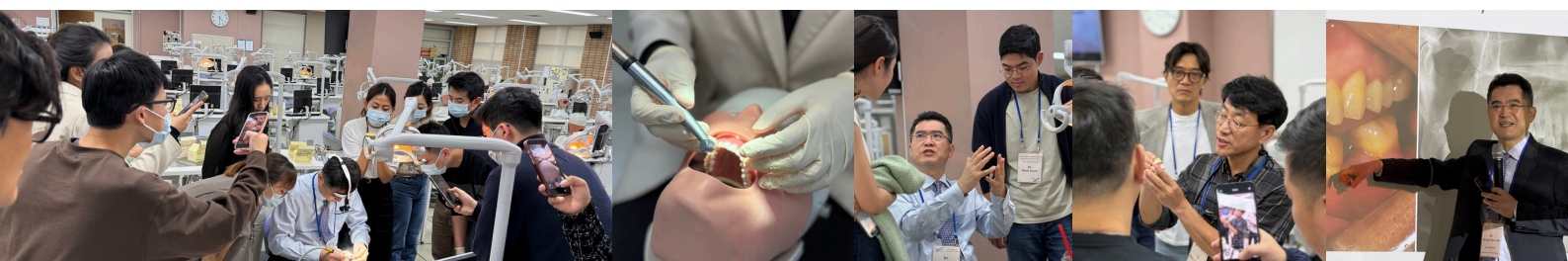

Rationale, Principle, & Focusing on Material Selection and Preparation Design

with Hands-on

Recently, all-ceramic crowns have become the mainstream choice for anterior restorations. All-ceramic crowns are largely divided into glass-ceramic and zirconia, which are poly-crystal materials. Specifically, they can be divided into veneer types that build up porcelain and monolithic types that do not build up porcelain. Depending on the type of restoration, the amount of anterior tooth removal should vary, and completing anterior tooth restoration with the minimum possible preparation guarantees a long-term prognosis. In this lecture, we will learn which restoration to choose for anterior teeth and the preparation process for anterior tooth crowns through practice.

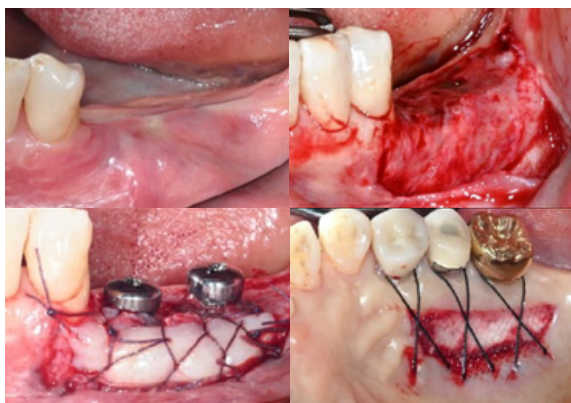
